Welcoming Guidance for New Residents

Welcome to San Antonio Village! We understand moving into an HOA-style community comes with certain expectations. The Board of Directors and Management hopes to simplify and convert our comprehensive governing documentation (CC&Rs, HOA rules, etc.) into a more easy-to-read, digestible list. Below, you will find a few rules/expectations that are most pertinent to your everyday living in San Antonio Village:

- 1. Meet with the Office before move-in to review rules and expectations
 - a. What's an HOA? What are the community's expectations of us?
- 2. Send the Office on-property Head of Household contact information (Name, email and phone number)
 - a. Used for Village notices and emergencies only
- 3. Common Area Guest Parking
 - a. Spaces are intended for guests and temporary parking
 - b. General rule of thumb: 2 Vehicles per Household
 - c. If there are 3 driving members of a Household, you may request Management approval to park a third vehicle in the common area
 - d. Unfortunately, fourth or fifth vehicles will be required to park outside of the Village (N. San Marcos Road)
- 4. Community driving speed: a cautious 10MPH (we have many kids playing around the common area)
- 5. Please be very aware of the rules for the Recreation Room and Pool Area (pool toys, guests, cognizant of child's activity, safety, etc.)
- 6. Remain aware of your Household's water use. Always contact the HOA if you notice any potential leaks
- 7. Trash/Recycle bins should be put out/brought in on collection day (usually Mondays). Otherwise, they should remain concealed.
- 8. No Smoking in the common area
- 9. Please clean up after your pet, especially in the common area

- 10. Be vigilant about your noise level. The Village is extremely quiet and peaceful
- 11. Work trucks/vans, motorhomes/campers/trailers, moving trucks/vans and any other housing/commercial vehicle may park on N. San Marcos Rd
- 12. Landscaping and "well-kept" umbrellas may extend past your patio fence line. Rule of thumb: Check with office before purchasing items that can be seen by the public
- 13. Umbrellas should look unseasoned and sprightly
- 14. All screens should appear clean and undamaged
- 15. Skateboarding within the Village is not permitted
